HOW TO SEEK THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD

1. Find a quiet place and remove distractions.

- a. Set an alarm to get up earlier so that the house is quiet as you seek the presence of the Lord.
- b. Place your phone in another room or on silent during your quiet time.

3. Focus on the Lord alone.

- a. Read a passage or verse (suggestions listed below) out loud, then silently and slowly. Allow the Spirit to guide you to focus on God's goodness, mercy, and instruction in the verse.
- b. What words jump out at you? How is God stirring your spirit as you read and speak His Word? Take note and talk with the Lord about it, asking for and waiting for a response.

2. Check your heart.

- a. Is there anything that you need to repent of? Unforgiveness, doubt, unbelief; anger and bitterness caused by the orphan or religious spirit are some of the major roadblocks that come up.
- b. Ask the Lord to reveal to you anything, known or unknown, that has caused the Holy Spirit to grieve or caused a rift between you and another person.

4. Set time apart each day to meet with Him.

- a. Every relationship takes time to develop. Your relationship with the Lord is no different. You are in a covenant relationship. You are a son or daughter of the King.
- b. As you seek His presence and meditate on His Word, the Spirit begins to reveal His heart to you, and through the spiritual discipline of studying the Word, you will experience more of His presence in your life.

7 VERSES TO GUIDE YOU INTO THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD

- 1. **Isaiah 50:4** The Lord God has given Me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him who is weary. He awakens Me morning by morning; He awakens My ear to hear as the learned.
- 2. **Jeremiah 33:3** Call to Me and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.
- 3. **Psalm 46:10** Be still and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!
- 4. **Psalm 42:1-2** As the deer pants for the water brooks, so pants my soul for You, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the Living God. When shall I come and appear before God?
- 5. **Psalm 9:10** And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; for You, Lord, have not forsaken those who seek You.
- 6. **Psalm 84:1-2** How lovely is Your tabernacle, O Lord of hosts! My soul longs, yes, even faints for the courts of the Lord; my heart and my flesh cry out for the living God.
- 7. **Psalm 27:8** When You said, 'Seek My face,' my heart said to You, 'Your face, Lord, I will seek.'

7 PROMISES TO DECREE IN THE PRESENCE OF THE LORD

1. **Matthew 11:28** Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Decree: I can approach the throne in Yeshua's name, and the Lord will give me rest.

2. John 14:14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

Decree: In Yeshua's name, I will seek the Lord's will and pray in accordance with His will. The Lord promises to answer these prayers.

3. **Matthew 6:33** But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added unto you.

Decree: In Yeshua's name, I will seek God's Kingdom above my own or any earthly kingdom. He promises to care for my every need.

4. **Matthew 7:7-8** Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

Decree: In Yeshua's name, I will seek the Lord, and He will open doors for me to opportunities.

5. **Deuteronomy 4:29-31** But from there you will seek the Lord your God, and you will find Him if you seek Him with all your heart and with all your soul. When you are in distress, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, when you turn to the Lord your God and obey His voice (for the Lord your God is a merciful God), He will not forsake you nor destroy you, nor forget the covenant of your fathers which He swore to them.

Decree: I will seek the Lord with all my heart and soul in Yeshua's name. I will turn to Him and obey His voice. He will not forsake nor destroy me.

- 6. **Proverbs 8:17** I love them that love me, and those that seek me early shall find me." **Decree**: In Yeshua's name, I seek the Lord. He loves me, and I am in a covenant relationship with Him.
- 7. **Jeremiah 29:12-14** Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart. I will be found by you, says the Lord, and I will bring you back from your captivity; I will gather you from all the nations and from all the places where I have driven you, says the Lord, and I will bring you to the place from which I cause you to be carried away captive.

Decree: In Yeshua's name, I call upon the Lord and search for Him with all my heart. He will listen to me and bring me back from captivity.

HEALING & DELIVERANCE

In life, we encounter many kinds of illnesses and problems. Sometimes, sickness, grief, or sadness can be so overwhelming that we can't get through it alone. It's easy to get stuck and feel like there's no way out. But remember, you're never alone through these tough times—God is always with you, offering His comforting presence.

Whatever your plight, there are Bible verses that can help you get through it.

PROVISIONS OF THE NEW COVENANT

On our part: Faith in God. Trust in God and Belief that Jesus was God in the flesh.

On God's part: Salvation, Eternal life, Forgiveness of all our sins through the death of his Son, Provision of the Holy Spirit to live within us and enable us to follow Christ.

POWER OF OUR AND HIS WORDS

The words we speak are powerful.

The Lord created the world with the spoken word, and He wants us to speak in agreement with His Word so that His name is glorified.

As a born-again believer, you have been healed. Yeshua has already separated your sin from you. Call on His name and declare His promises because you are a son or daughter of the King of kings and Lord of lords.

His word does not return void (Isaiah 55:11). Speaking out His Word and decreeing it with the authority you have in Christ releases angels. They obey God's Word (Psalm 103:20).

WHAT DOES THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT HEALING?

Read these verses to remind yourself of God's healing power and strengthen your resolve to pull through. Healing can take time, so be patient and keep yourself close to God. Read through the verses every day to remind yourself of God's love. Turn these scriptures into confessions, and put them into practice!

Exodus 15:26 He said, 'If you listen carefully to the Lord your God and do what is right in His eyes if you pay attention to His commands and keep all His decrees, I will not bring on you any of the diseases I brought on the Egyptians, for I am the Lord, who heals you.'

Exodus 23:25 Worship the Lord your God, and His blessing will be on your food and water. I will take away sickness from among you," There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfill.

Deuteronomy 7:14-15 Thou shalt be blessed above all people: there shall not be male or female barren among you, or among your cattle. And the Lord will take away from thee all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon thee; but will lay them upon all them that hate thee.

Deuteronomy 30:19-20 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live: That thou mayest love the Lord thy God, and that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he is thy life, and the length of thy days: that thou mayest dwell in the land which the Lord sware unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them.

1 Kings 8:56 Blessed be the Lord, that hath given rest unto his people Israel, according to all that he promised: there hath not failed one word of all his good promise, which he promised by the hand of Moses his servant.

2 Chronicles 7:14-15 If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. Now my eyes will be open and my ears attentive to the prayers offered in this place.

Psalm 23:4 Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

Psalm 30:2 Lord my God, I called to You for help, and You healed me.

Psalm 41:3 The Lord sustains them on their sickbed and restores them from their bed of illness.

Psalm 73:26 My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

Psalm 91:9-14 If you say, 'The Lord is my refuge,' and you make the Most High your dwelling, no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent. For He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone. You will tread on the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent. "Because he loves me," says the Lord, "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges My name."

Psalm 91:15-16 He will call on me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him. With long life, I will satisfy him and show him my salvation.

Psalm 103:2-5 Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all His benefits—who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Psalm 147:3 He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

Psalm 118:17 I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord.

Psalm 146:8 The Lord gives sight to the blind, the Lord lifts up those who are bowed down, the Lord loves the righteous.

Psalm 107:17,19-21 Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted. Then they cry unto the Lord in their trouble, and he saved them out of their distresses. He sent his word and healed them and delivered them from their destruction. Oh, that men would praise the Lord for his goodness and for his wonderful works to the children of men!

Proverbs 4:20-24 My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them and health to all their flesh. Keep thy heart with all diligence, for out of it are the issues of life. Put away from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee.

Isaiah 38:16-17 Lord, by such things people live; and my spirit finds life in them too. You restored me to health and let me live. Surely, it was for my benefit that I suffered such anguish. In Your love, You kept me from the pit of destruction; You have put all my sins behind your back.

Isaiah 40:29 He gives strength to the weary and increases the power of the weak.

Isaiah 41:10 So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

Isaiah 53:4-5 Surely, he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions; He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds, we are healed.

Isaiah 57:18-19 I have seen their ways, but I will heal them; I will guide them and restore comfort to Israel's mourners, creating praise on their lips. Peace, peace, to those far and near,' says the Lord. 'And I will heal them.'

Jeremiah 17:14 Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise.

Jeremiah 30:17 For I will restore health unto thee, and I will heal thee of thy wounds, saith the Lord.

Jeremiah 33:6 Nevertheless, I will bring health and healing to it; I will heal my people and will let them enjoy abundant peace and security.

Hosea 6:1 Come, let us return to the Lord. He has torn us to pieces, but He will heal us; He has injured us, but He will bind up our wounds.

Nahum 1:9 What do ye imagine against the Lord? He will make an utter end: affliction shall not rise up the second time.

Malachi 4:2 But for you who revere my name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its rays. And you will go out and frolic like well-fed calves.

Matthew 8:2-3 And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately, his leprosy was cleansed.

Matthew 8:16-17 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

Matthew 11:28-30 Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

Matthew 15:30-31 And great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them: insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.

Matthew 18:18-19 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again, I say unto you that if two of you agree on earth as touching anything that they ask, it shall be done for them of my Father, who is in heaven.

Matthew 21:21-22 Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.

Mark 5:34 He said to her, 'Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering.'

Mark 9:23 Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.

Mark 10:27 And Jesus looking upon them saith, With men it is impossible, but not with God: for with God all things are possible.

Mark 11:22-24 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore, I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Mark 16:14-18 Afterward, he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen. And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Luke 4: 18-19 "The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, and recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.

Luke 6:19 And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him and healed them all.

Luke 9:2 And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.

Luke 13:16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day?

Acts 5:16 There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed everyone.

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Romans 5:3-5 Not only so, but we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope. And hope does not put us to shame because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us.

Romans 4:16-21 Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all, (as it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were. Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about a hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb: He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; and being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

Romans 8:2,11 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, He will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

2 Corinthians 4:18 While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ.

Philippians 4:19 And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus.

James 5:14-16 Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven." "Therefore, confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective."

Galatians 3:13-14, 29 Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is everyone that hangeth on a tree: that the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Ephesians 6:10-17 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; and your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

Philippians 2:13 [Not in your own strength] for it is God Who is all the while effectually at work in you [energizing and creating in you the power and desire], both to will and to work for His good pleasure and satisfaction and delight.

Philippians 4:6-9 Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything, by prayer and petition (definite requests), with thanksgiving, continue to make your wants known to God. And God's peace [shall be yours, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and being content with its earthly lot of whatever sort that is, that peace] which transcends all understanding shall garrison and mount guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. For the rest, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is worthy of reverence and is honorable and seemly, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely and lovable, whatever is kind and winsome and gracious, if there is any virtue and excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think on and weigh and take account of these things [fix your minds on them]. Practice what you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, and model your way of living on it, and the God of peace (of untroubled, undisturbed well-being) will be with you.

- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.
- **1 Peter 2:24** Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.
- **1 John 3:21-22** Beloved, if our heart condemns us not, then have we confidence toward God. And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.
- **1 John 5:14-15** And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask anything according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.
- **3 John 2** Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

Revelations 21:4 He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.

HOW DO I PRAY THESE SCRIPTURES?

Now that you've been introduced to some healing Scriptures to pray and declare, you may wonder how to actually use them. The Holy Spirit is the best guide when it comes to knowing how to pray each scripture, but here is an example demonstrating how easy it can be to turn God's Word into personal prayer:

God, Psalm 103:1-6 speaks of Your goodness and generosity; I stand firmly on that truth.

I speak unto my soul and all that I am that I will bless the Lord, and for all Your

benefits, I will recall how loving and kind You are, my Great God!

I thank You for Your Body and Blood that was given over for my sake and the forgiveness of all of my iniquities. I lay hold of my healing, for it has been paid for by You and declared in Your very Word!

I accept the full truth of Your goodness and receive Your redemption from destruction, along with every measure of Your lovingkindness and tender mercies. I thank You for satisfying my mouth with good things; I am renewed like the eagle!

My loving God, You execute righteousness and justice for the oppressed. I thank You for doing so on my behalf, and I receive the fullness of what that means to my body, soul, and mind.

You are wonderful, God, and I thank You and bless Your Holy Name!

I seal it now in Yeshua's Name! Amen!

7 VERSES TO DECREE FOR EMOTIONAL HEALING

- 1. 1 Peter 5:10 But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you. Decree: In Yeshua's name, the God of grace has called me to His eternal glory. After I suffer for a while, I am perfected, established, strengthened, and settled.
- 2. **Psalm 34:17-18** The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears and delivers them out of all their troubles. The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart and saves such as have a contrite spirit.

Decree: In Yeshua's name, I cry out to the Lord, and He delivers me from my troubles. He heals my broken heart and saves me.

3. **Psalm 23:3** He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake.

Decree: In Yeshua's name, the Lord restores my soul. He leads me into righteousness, and I will follow. He will do this for His name's sake.

4. **Psalm 51:10** Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Decree: In Yeshua's name, I am a new creation and have a clean heart. The Lord renews a steadfast spirit within me.

5. **Isaiah 54:17** 'No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is from Me,' says the Lord.

Decree: In Yeshua's name, any weapon from the enemy will not succeed in its assignment. I have an inheritance as a servant of the Lord. My righteousness comes from Him. I cancel any judgment against me.

6. **Psalm 103:1-4** Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: who forgives all your iniquities, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from destruction, who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies.

Decree: In Yeshua's name, I bless the Lord! He crowns me with lovingkindness and tender mercies every day. He forgives and heals me. He has restored and redeemed me; I will declare His benefits daily!

7. **2 Corinthians 12:9** And He said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore, most gladly, I will rather boast in my infirmities that the power of Christ may rest upon me."

Decree: In Yeshua's name, His strength is manifested in my weakness. His grace is sufficient to heal every emotional and physical wound.

7 DECLARATIONS TO ACTIVATE HEALING FOR EMOTIONAL WOUNDS

- 1. "Father God, in the name of Yeshua, I humbly come to You. Your Word says that I have Your mind. Father God, I decree and declare that my mind, will, and emotions align with Your mind. Father, send Your Spirit to shape my mind so that Your covenant promises of emotional healing manifest in my life. I give my emotional wounds to You, and Your Word says I am healed, in Jesus' name, amen."
- 2. "Father God, in the name of Yeshua, I decree and declare that I come out of agreement with any false truth or lie of deception that sets itself up against you. I cast out any words, snares, and curses that have attached to me because of emotional hurts. I recall to mind the pain of those hurts and let it go, fully trusting that You have and will deal with it according to Your perfect justice, in Jesus' name, amen."
- 3. "Father God, I come to You in the name of Yeshua. I renounce all lies I have spoken out because of emotional wounds. I have spoken words against myself, others, and even against You, Lord. I renounce and come out of agreement with these words, repenting and turning from these wicked thoughts and words. I request, in Jesus' name, for healing to come. Release healing upon me and my family according to Your merciful character and covenantal love, in Jesus' name, amen."
- 4. "Father God, I come to You in the name of Yeshua. According to Luke 22:20 and 1 Corinthians 11:25, I received and drank communion, the cup of the New Covenant. I activate the blessings of the New Covenant today, fully thanking You with my whole heart that I can be a part of this extraordinary covenant blessing that You freely offer through Jesus and ask that You send ministering angels to watch over me, and I will not come out of agreement with Your Word, in Jesus' name, amen."
- 5. "Father God, I come to You in the name of Yeshua. With my hands lifted high, I give thanks, praising Your name above all others. I give a shout and a handclap, dancing for joy in Your presence. May the meditation of my heart and the words of my mouth be a pleasing aroma to You, Father. You sent Your best—Yeshua (Jesus)—to redeem me, and I respond with a thankful heart and a song of worship. I release a spirit of thanksgiving into the atmosphere today, in Jesus' name, amen."
- 6. "Father God, I come to You in the name of Yeshua. I decree and declare that spending time in Your Word strengthens and empowers me to receive healing for emotional wounds. Father God, I know that when I spend time with You and meditate on Your Word, the Word will not come back void. Let my life, time, and seasons be pleasing to You. I decree and declare, according to Your covenant promises, that as I draw near to You, You will draw near to me, healing my emotional wounds by Your covenant promises, in Jesus' name, Amen."
- 7. "Father God, I decree and declare that the seeds I sow will be planted in fertile soil. Every Word I speak is a seed that will reproduce according to its kind. I decree and declare that the words I speak come into alignment with Your Word and will plant seeds that heal emotional wounds in my life and others. Father God, I will consume the instruction of Your Word, and it will consume me, equipping me to sow into the healing You have for me, in Jesus' name, amen."

7 STEPS TO HELP YOU HEAL EMOTIONALLY

- 1. Allow yourself to feel: It's important to experience your emotions instead of avoiding or suppressing them. This can help you understand and accept your feelings.
- 2. Be aware: Increasing your awareness of your emotions can help you reconnect with your needs and become more motivated to find happiness.
- 3. Practice mindfulness: Mindfulness meditation can help you reduce stress and control your emotions. It can also help you become less judgmental of your thoughts and feelings.
- 4. Take care of yourself: Make self-care a regular part of your routine, especially when healing from trauma. Recovery can be draining, so take time to rest and recharge.
- 5. Be patient and persistent: Healing takes time, so be patient and allow yourself to gain new insights and skills.
- 6. Build resilience: Develop healthy habits, practice gratitude, and explore your beliefs. You can also look at problems from different angles and tap into your social connections.
- 7. **Seek help**: If you need help, you can talk to a mental health professional.

- 1. Matthew 17:20 If you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible
- 2. James 1:6 But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.
- 3. Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.
- 4. **2 Corinthians 5:7** For we live by faith, not by sight.

THE PRAYER OF FAITH

Audacity isn't the absence of uncertainty and ambiguity.
Audacity is believing that God's promise is bigger than my perhaps.

Lessons from 1 Samuel 14: 1-14

1. The Prayer of Faith must be accompanied by repentance, confession of sin, and amendment of life. (v3-6)

Only as hindrances are removed can we pray the prayer of faith. (Psalm 66:18, Isaiah 59:1-2)

2. The Prayer of Faith will be challenged by doubts and fears, but it will persist despite every discouragement. (v7-8)

But faith is always beset by doubts and fears. But turn away from the circumstances to the Lord (Matthew 14:25-33, Joshua 6:1-5, 20)

3. The Prayer of Faith is specific and is directed to the Lord. $(\vee 8)$

The Lord invites us and wants us to be specific and definite in our prayers. He encourages us to tell Him exactly what we need, and He promises to meet our needs.

What is your need just now?

Look to Him and ask Him to meet your need. (Philippians 4:19, Psalm 50:14-15).

- 4. The Prayer of Faith must be offered on the grounds of a blood sacrifice. (v9) There is only one way to approach and enter the presence of a holy God; it is by the "new and living way," sprinkled with Jesus' atoning blood. (Hebrews 10:19-22)
- 5. The Prayer of Faith will always be challenged by the powers of darkness. (v10) Satan fiercely challenges us as we seek to draw near to the Lord in worship and prayer. (Ephesians 6:10-18, Daniel 10:10-21
- 6. **The Prayer of Faith is a prayer that is always answered**. (v10, 13-14) Every prayer offered in faith, in the Name of Jesus and for the glory of God, is always answered abundantly. (John 14:13-14, Ephesians 3:20-21
- 7. The Prayer of Faith is a prayer that gives God all the glory. (v 11-12) Ebenezer"! God has done it! His is the victory! (Psalm 126:3)
